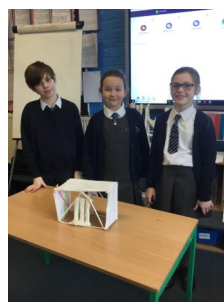
God's Word is a lamp to guide our feet and a light for our path.
