

History- Rosa Parks and Emily Davison

In History, the children will be learning about Rosa Parks and Emily Davison. The class will discuss the topic of equal rights in relation to Park's and Davison. They will explore what Rosa Park's and Emily Davison did and the reason as to why they felt the need to protest. The children will discuss how their action changed society, including the lives of children.

Computing- Questioning

In computing this half term, the children will be learning about the importance of phrasing questions. Following our Purple Mash curriculum programme, they will explore how certain data-handling resources are limited in the answers they can provide.

French - Pets

Middle school will learning French vocabulary, phrases and grammar structure that will help them to talk about pets. There will be a focus on helping the children understand masculine and feminine nouns in French.

Geography- Continents and Oceans

In Geography, the children will be identifying the 7 continents and 5 oceans on a map. They will explore the difference between the continent's landscapes, features and weather. The children will discuss what continents are suitable to inhabit and why.

Art - Print

In Art, the children will be learning about print and how it is a process of making images that can be transferred onto other surfaces. They will create different prints by using objects such as sponges, fruit and vegetables. They will explore the techniques of pressing, rolling and stamping to effectively make our prints. Finally, the children will identify what a repeating pattern is.

Year 2/3

Spring 1

Music- I Wanna Play in a Band

In this unit of music, the children will learn about rock music through learning to sing 'I Wanna Play in a Band'. They will also listen to and talk about other well-known rock songs. The class will discuss typical instruments used for rock music. The children will learn to listen, answer questions and find the pulse for rock songs.

RE

Middle School will be looking into the Christian faith. They will explore and discuss the meaning of incarnation and the Holy Trinity.

PE- Dancing

The children will respond to music by dancing. They will perform dances with a range of movement patterns.

English

In English, the children will be delving into the features of recount. Middle school will write their own structured recount in the past tense.

PSHE

In PSHE, the children will be identifying and discussing their dreams and goals.

Science- Animals including humans

In Science, the children will explore that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. The children will identify what baby animals become as an adult animal. They will discuss how animals, including humans, need exercise, balanced diet, and good hygiene to survive.

Maths

In maths, the children will be learning how to identify fractions of shapes and numbers. The children will also learn to measure length in metres and centimetres, and weight in kilograms and grams.
