

### History- Henry VIII

In History, we will be learning all about the Tudor Monarchs, Henry VIII and his 6 wives and why the Tower of London was important in the Tudor times and what it was used for.

### Computing- Writing for audiences

In computing this half term, we will be learning how to use different fonts and formats for each text type.

### French-
