

History- WW2

In History, we will be continuing with our topic of WW2. This half term we will be learning about the Holocaust, Anne Frank, the Battle of Britain and how the war ended.

Computing-

In computing this half term, we will be looking at Online Safety and Databases.

French-

This term we will be learning all about directions: asking for them and giving them.

Geography- Human and Physical features in the UK.

In Geography, we will be discovering human and physical features of the UK and finding them on maps; explaining which region, county or city/town they can be found in.

DT- Sewing

In DT, Upper School will be creating their own pencil cases by designing something fit for purpose that uses various stitches and openings. They will be making prototypes to ensure the final piece is fantastic!

Music-

RE- Islam

This half term, we will be learning about how light travels, how we can see, shadows and we will also be investigating if light can bend in water.
